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## The Project

The “Stepping Up to Technology in Adult Education towards Awareness, Assessment and Access” is an ERASMUS+ - project (2017-2019) focusing on building the ICT capacity of adult educators in their specific occupational context. The professional development and the quality of educators is one of the most important factors in shaping the quality of adult learning. Adult learning staff help learners to develop knowledge, skills and attitudes. But the traditional role of the educator increasingly changes into that of a coach, a facilitator and a moderator. New professional skills are required for working in new (online and digital) learning environments, to include learning strategies based on ICT (e-learning, blended learning) in the classroom, and to guide and support adult learners throughout their learning

### First Project meeting in Fano, Italy

The project started in October 2017, and the first kick-off meeting was held in Fano, Italy, on 14th and 15th November 2017. The partners discussed the project results, related activities and the timeline for delivery.


